

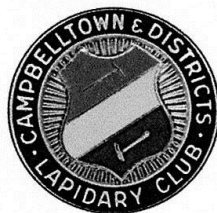

 (Tin 8" x 12" or 21cm x 30 cm)

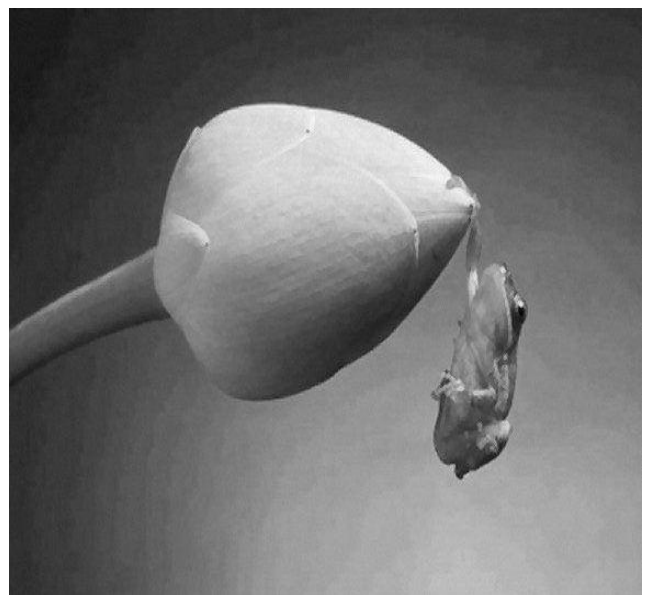
Cook in moderate oven for 12 – 15 minutes.
