Recipe

Drumsticks with Sweet Potato

1/4 cup plain flour

8 (1kg) chicken drumsticks

1 ½ tblsp vegetable oil

1 onion, roughly chopped

1 red capsicum, roughly chopped

1 large (600g) orange sweet potato, peeled, cut into 4cm pieces

400g can diced tomatoes

2 tblsp tomato paste

Basil

- 1. Season flour with salt & pepper. Toss chicken drumsticks in seasoned flour. Heat 1 tablespoon of the oil in a large pan, add drumsticks & pan-fry until golden. Remove from pan.
- 2. Heat remaining oil in same pan, add onion & capsicum sauté for 2-3 minutes. Return drumsticks to pan, add sweet potato, tomatoes & tomato paste. Reduce heat & simmer covered for 30 minutes.
- 3. Remove lid, simmer uncovered for a further 20 30 minutes until chicken & sweet potato are tender & sauce has thickened. Stir in basil. Serve with steamed beans, if desired.

Serves 4. Can be cooked ahead of time & reheated.



HINT:

If you have any old talc that you don't want (or you are carving soapstone), sprinkle spare talc on your garden & mix it a little with the topsoil to get rid of unwanted snails. *They just don't like talc*.
