# **Recipe**

# Coconut Currant Slice

BASE
125g (4oz) butter
<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla
1egg
<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup plain flour
<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup self-raising flour
<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup milk

FILLING
½ cup jam
1 cup currants

TOPPING 60g (2oz) butter 1/4 cup sugar 1egg

2 tablespoons self-raising flour 1½ cups coconut

#### Base:

Cream butter, sugar, vanilla and egg until light and creamy, stir in sifted flours and milk. Spread mixture evenly over base of well-greased 30cm x 25cm (12in x 10in) swiss roll tin.

Spread evenly with jam, sprinkle with currants. Use fork to spread topping evenly over currants. Bake in moderately hot oven for 10 minutes; reduce heat to moderate, bake further 10 to 15 minutes, or until golden brown.

Stand 10 minutes before cutting.

Cool pieces on wire rack.

#### **Topping:**

Cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy, add egg, beat until combined, stir in sifted flour then coconut in two lots.
