Recipe

Empanadas Chilenas - Chilean Meat Turnovers

Ingredients

Dough

4 cups of plain flour

1 flat teaspoon baking powder

1 flat tablespoon salt

3 eggs yolks (save the egg white to seal the empanadas)

4 tablespoons of oil

 $1\frac{1}{4}$ to $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups of warm milk

enough oil for deep fry Preparation

Pour the flour on a deep bowl. Make a depression in the center and add the baking powder and salt. Mix well using your fingers, then adds the egg yolks lightly whisked and the 4 tablespoons of oil. Mix well using your fingers and the last thing add the warm milk, make dough until it is smooth and fairly stiff.

Then roll the dough to about 1/8 inch thick or thinner, then cut circles about 5 inches in diameter.

Place 1 full tablespoons of Pino in the center of each pastry circle, making sure there is at least one olive, egg wedge and 2 or 3 golden raisins. Dip your fingers in the egg white and run them around the pastry edge. Fold the dough to make a semicircular turnover. Press around the filling removing the trapped air and sealing the turnover. Use a fork to make a decorative edge. Cook the empanadas in deep fry until golden brown. Serve hot.

Pino filling - Prepare Pino Filling a day in advance

Ingredients

1/2 to 3/4 kilo Beef mince
2 large onions, peeled and finely chopped
3 boiled eggs
2 garlic cloves, peeled and crushed
1 teaspoon of sweet paprika
1 teaspoon of dried oregano
Oil for frying onions and beef mince
1/2 cup of golden raisins

24 pitted olives

Solt to tosta

Salt to taste

Prepare Pino filling

In large frying pan, pour the oil and sauté the onions and garlic until translucent Add the paprika, oregano and a pinch of salt, Set aside. In another pan, pour oil and sauté the beef; do not brown or overcook. Combine the onion and beef mixture in the large pan. Cook the mixture over low heat, stirring well; the end result should be juicy, add the salt to taste.

Cover and store overnight in the refrigerator.

Pino is the juicy and spicy meat filling used in several of the classic Chilean criolla recipes such as Empanadas, Pastel de choclo, Pastel de papas and Pastel Relleno. Pino is what makes Empanadas Chilenas so different from the empanadas made in Spain and other Latin American countries.

Coriander Dip (PEBRE DIP)

Ingredients

1 bunch coriander (chop finely)

½ medium size brown onion (dice finely)

½ -1 garlic (as preferred)

Juice of 1/2 lemon

2 tablespoons oil

Salt to taste 1 -2 teaspoons

Chili paste 1 -2 teaspoons (according to taste)

Mix above ingredients well to a thick consistency, add 1 -2 tablespoon of boiling water to reduce consistency.

Texture/consistency is like a dip, not too runny and not too thick.

TASTE and adjust as needed? More salt, lemon juice.

Prepare 1-2 hours ahead.

Maybe kept in fridge up to 4 days

(Carolina's recipe for a traditional Chilean dip)
