At a general meeting on May 5th 1976 it was proposed that the club name be changed to Campbelltown City Lapidary Club but an extraordinary meeting was held on July 7th 1976 when the name Campbelltown & Districts Lapidary Club was decided on. Also in 1976 on September 1st the club decided to change the club badge. The old badge was incorporated into the new badge which we still use. 100 badges were ordered from Perfection Plate Pty Ltd who still have the artwork for re-ordering.

In 1978 it was decided to build a 24 ïnch diamond saw. Ken Cole constructed the tank and Doug Burden, a partner in D.J. Batchen Pty Ltd, helped by John Reid took over the final construction. At the meeting on June 6th 1979, it was announced that the new saw was complete. Thanks were extended to D.J. Batchen Pty Ltd for their donation of parts and labour.
